Your recipient will be automatically emailed a gift certificate outlining their gift (you get to choose the certificate design and when you want them to receive it). Your brand will be included on the email (see below example) and for an additional fee can be included on the gift certificate.



IT'S SUPER EASY TO GET STARTED:

- If you're not already registered with us, register a business profile at <https://grow.treesthatcount.co.nz/register>, this will create a Tree Profile for your business which will celebrate your impact as a native tree funder

- Choose a [gift certificate design](#)
- Want your own design? No problem. We can provide a template and you can have your own designer create something, or apply your brand to one of ours for an additional fee
- We can invoice you, or you can pay by credit card on our website (by logging in once registered and funding a planting)
- Once payment is received we'll send your gift certificates out
- Fill out our template which includes the names, email addresses and personalised messages for your recipients and return to us
- We manage all of the distribution, so we can email the gifts for you, with your brand and message included on the email and in the certificate
- Want to pass them on yourself? No problem, we can send you all of the PDF gift certificates and you can send them on yourself
